5. Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship

D Y Patil International University (DYPIU) will award the Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship (**Max. Nos. 03**) for the students who have exhibited excellence in academic activities other than conventional examinations every year.

Eligibility:

1. Students with NO DUES are allowed to apply.
2. Students must not bear any backlog.

3. Students must have secured good positions (up to 1000 ranks) in any State/ National/ International level academic even such as Math Olympiad/ Science Olympiad/ Hackathon etc. during the past academic year.
4. The student cannot avail more than one Scholarship/ Fellowship form D Y Patil International University (DYPIU) in the same year.
5. Student should be a bonafide student.

Criteria:

Top scorer students with any State/ National/ International level Academic achievements evaluated by a panel

Scheme: Up to 50% Waiver in tuition fee

Note:

- No Fellowship Will be awarded if the candidate is not found suitable by the panel formed by the Vice-Chancellor.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor will be final.

8. Economically Weaker Section

Introduction: With a view to facilitate access to higher education to persons who belong to specific category and whose annual family income is below a certain limit, DYPIU offers a financial aid. The benefits, process of applications submission, and selection of applications pertaining to scheme are detailed below:

Objectives of the Scheme: To provide financial assistance to students who need support for pursuing their higher education and to increase attainment and enhance their employability.

Eligibility for Application: An application who belong to any of the categories covered under the scheme i.e., Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and special categories that includes Single Girl Child and Single Mother (Refer definitions for more details about the categories)

Benefits under the scheme: The benefits of 50% financial aid on programme fee as financial aid will be award ed to selected applicants. The details are mentioned below:

SNo	Categories	Annual Family Income	Benefits as Financial Aid
1	For students from Economically weaker section	Equal to Less than 800,000/- per annum	50% of the tuition fee when not getting any other scholarship.
2.	For Special Categories (Single girl child and Single mother)	Equal to less than 500,000/- per annum	30% of the tuition fee when not getting any other scholarship.

Categories wise definition and document requirements for purpose of admissibility of this scheme:

Annual Family Income- Consolidated annual income of all the earning members in the family, that shall also include income from all sources I e , salary, agriculture, business or profession,

rent or other sources for the financial year of application.(i.e. for admission in 2025-26, the income certificate is prepared or issued in the previous year (s) then it must have validity till 30.September 2025 and the same must be mentioned on the certificate.)

Concerned Authority- The application is required to provide an affidavit under different categories that must be duly signed and stamped by the concerned authority that means not below the rank of tehsildar. The Executive Magistrate, District Magistrate, Collector, Sub Divisional Magistrate may be considered under the concerned authority. Note: In case, an applicant is minor (Less than 18 years), the affidavit can be countersigned by parent/ guardian or can be submitted by parent/ guardian for the applicant. Any applicant whose annual family income is less than Rs. 8 lakhs will be considered as a person from economically weaker section of the society.

Document required are mentioned below:

- Economically Weaker Section Certificate issued by the concerned authority in the state is mandatory requirement by general category applicants and for others caste certificate is mandatory.
- Income Certificate issued from a Concerned Authority (Tehsildar, District Magistrate, Collector, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, or other relevant district authorities) in the State/UT Government is required in respect of the parent/ guardian of an applicant in all the categories or subcategories (computerized income certificate issued by Sewa Kendra will be preferred).

Note: An Income Declaration as per the university Performa will also be required irrespective of category applied by the applicant.

9. Need Based- financial Aid

a) Single Girl Child – means that the child is only a girl child and she has no real brother or sister.

Document required are mentioned below:

- Application Form for Need Based Financial Aid-2025.
- Affidavit on prescribed Performa of the university is required from parent of applicant (girl) on a stamp paper of minimum Rs. 100/-; the affidavit duly signed and stamped from the Tehsildar or Executive Magistrate.
- Income Certificate issued from a Concerned Authority (Tehsildar, District Magistrate, Collector, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, or other relevant district authorities) in the State/UT Government is required in respect of the parent/ guardian of an applicant in all the categories or subcategories (computerised income certificate issued by Sewa Kendra will be preferred).

Note: An Income Declaration as per the university Performa will also be required irrespective of category applied by the applicant.

b) Single Mother Child – means the child looked after by the mother alone without a husband or partner; The woman may be divorced or whose husband/partner is dead.

Document required are mentioned below:

- Application Form for Need Based Financial Aid.
- Affidavit on prescribed Performa of the University is required from mother of the applicant on a stamp paper of minimum Rs. 100/-; the affidavit duly signed and stamped from the Tehsildar or Executive Magistrate.
- Supporting Document: The death certificate of husband or divorce certificate (whichever is applicable) is to be submitted compulsorily.
- Income Certificate issued from a Concerned Authority (Tehsildar, District Magistrate, Collector, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, or other relevant district authorities) in the State/UT Government is required in respect of the parent/ guardian of an applicant in all the categories or subcategories (computerized income certificate issued by Sewa Kendra will be preferred).

Note: An Income Declaration as per the university Performa will also be required irrespective of category applied by the application.

c). Financial Aid for Orphans Application

Introduction

DYPIU is committed to creating an inclusive and accessible learning environment for all. As part of this, the university offers financial to orphan students. This financial aid scheme aims to empower students by removing financial barriers and enabling them to pursue higher education.

Who Can Apply:

A child whose both parents are dead, or he/she is an abandoned child.

The applicant is not legally adopted by any individual or couple or group.

Benefits Offered:

Full Program fee waiver plus Examination fee waiver.

Seats Offered:

A total of 1-2 % seats are offered under the scheme in selective program.

Programme Considered:

The applications are accepted in all programmes

The Programmes after Graduation and Higher Degrees are not considered for benefits.

Document Required:

Application Form for Orphan Financial Aid Scheme

Death certificate of both the parents.

Income declaration form (Guardian/ Self-if employed) as per university Performa.

Letter of recommendation from a government approved orphanage, where the applicant is currently residing.

or

Affidavit from Applicant/Guardian on Rs100/- Stamp paper signed by executive magistrate; in case applicant is not living in government approved orphanage.

Education Documents, Class 10th Mark sheet is mandatory along with other previous qualification documents.

Any other document, as required by the committee members or university from time to time

10.RAKSHAK SAMMAAN

Introduction

This financial aid scheme aims to honor the sacrifices and dedication of our brave defense and CAPF personnel by offering financial assistance to them and their dependents for their higher education, encouraging academic success across generations.

Who Can Apply

The applicant's parent(s) must be a serving or retired member of the Indian Armed Forces, CAPF, or allied organizations.

- **Indian Armed Forces:** Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Air Force, Indian Coast Guard
- **Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF):** Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Border Security force (BSF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), National Security Guards (NSG)
- **Allied Forces/ Organizations:** Railway Protection Force (RPF), Special Frontier Force (SFF), Assam Rifles, Border Road Organization, General Reserve Engineer Force (GREF), Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO), Military Engineers Service (MES), Defence Security Corps (DSC), Ordnance Factory Board.
- **Gallantry Awards Considered:** ParamVir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Mahavir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Veer Chakra & Shaurya Chakra, President's Tatrakshak Medal and Tatrakshak Medal, President's Police medal for Gallantry, President's Police Medal for Meritorious Service, President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service, President's Police medal, Sena medal.
- **Admission Eligibility:** The applicants must meet the general admission criteria for their chosen programme of study at the university.

11. Persons with Disabilities

Introduction

DYPIU is committed to creating an inclusive and accessible learning environment for all. As part of this, the university offers a financial aid scheme for persons with benchmark disabilities and those with locomotor disabilities caused by spinal cord injury. This scheme aims to empower students by removing the financial barriers and enabling them to pursue higher education.

Who Can Apply:

A person having not less than 70% (Seventy percent) of a specified disability where disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. (Excluding Deaf & Dumb disability)

Benefits Offered:

Full programme fee waiver plus Examination fee waiver.

Seats Offered:

A total of 1-2 % seats are offered under the scheme in selective programmes.

Programme Considered:

The applications are accepted in all programmes.

Documents Required:

Application Form for Person with certain Disability Financial Aid Scheme 2025.

UDID Card (Unique Disability Identity Card) is a mandatory requirement.

Certificate of Disability, medical proof from competent medical authority (Certificate issued by Chief Medical officer).

Income declaration form of (Parent/ Guardian/ Self-If employed) as per university Performa.

Any other document required by the committee from time to time.

12.Natural Calamities

Document Required:

- Application form.
- Residence proof of the area affected by natural Calamity.
- Certificate from the competent authority.

13. Sports Scholarship**Guideline 1: Eligibility**

1.1 Sports Scholarships are available to all Students of D Y Patil International University Pune, subject to their meeting the prescribed norms

1.2. Minimum age of students shall be above 18 years of age at the time of application

1.3 The student shall have to produce documentary evidence in support of his/her credentials to the Scholarship

1.4 The student aspiring for Scholarship shall possess Certificates of Achievement for the preceding two [2] years

- 2.1 The eligible Students should apply for the Sports Scholarship in the prescribed form available in the Physical Education Department and submit the form, duly filled in all respects with all supporting Certificates.
- 2.2 The Students will have to undergo selection trials, to be conducted by **the** Physical Education Department and the performance and skill sets in the prescribed Sport will be evaluated and certified by a Panel of three [3] Members comprising the Dean of Student Affairs or his/her Nominee and two other Members with strong credentials in respect of the Sport being played by the respective Student. The decision of the Panel shall be final and binding and in the unlikely event of a dispute, the decision of the Dean-Student Affairs shall prevail.
- 2.3 Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Student can only claim the higher of the Scholarship should s/he represent the University, District, Zone, State or Country in any approved Sport/Game, as may be notified by the University as part of its Sports Policy.
- 2.4 Participation Certificates or Certificates of Achievement, at National Level Competitions shall only be considered as valid supporting document for purposes of grant of Sports Scholarship, if the Student has participated at these Meets through the State Association that have been approved by the Sports Authority of India or the Indian Olympic Association, as more fully notified .

2.5 Similarly, participation Certificates or Certificates of Achievement, at International Level Competitions, including Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Olympics or such other International Sport, shall only be considered as valid supporting document for purposes of grant of Sports Scholarship, if the Student has participated at these Meets through the respective National Association that have been approved by the Sports Authority of India or the Indian Olympic Association, as more fully stated in Clause 3 below.

2.6 The Scholarship is first granted for any given Academic Year based on his/her prior performance. The continuity of the Scholarship for the subsequent Academic Years of the cycle during his/her years of Study, at D Y Patil International University Pune, based on the immediate past performance and subject to meeting the following parameters

03	Achieving Medals at State/ Inter University/ National/ International level Events as approved by IOA / SAI / Federation / Council / Board / AIU
04	Participating (as and when required) in the functions conducted by Department of Sports
05	Achieving a minimum score of 70% at the Fitness Test conducted, annually, during the last week of April. The Test format will be as decided by the Sports Director
