Introduction:

The institution encourages participation of students in Sports and Games and NSS at National level to strengthen nationwide bond and relation. The institution takes many initiatives, like for example, conducting awareness campaigns, organizing orientation programmes, training programmes, seminars and workshops to sensitize the future leaders to inherit human values and coping with the constitutional obligations. The institution has moved forward with great effort to increase the level of awareness and by inculcating appropriate practices among the students. The students have enthusiastically participated in various activities like seminar, conferences, expert talks, and poster making competition.
